Riley Institute Senior Fellow and DLI Leader Juan Johnson Joins Board of Trustees

GREENVILLE, S.C.—Juan Johnson, a Senior Fellow in the Riley Institute at Furman University and the facilitator for the Diversity Leaders Initiatives, has been elected to the Furman Board of Trustees.

Johnson will begin his term on July 1 and serve a three-year, renewable term. Trustees rotate off the board for at least one year after a total of six consecutive years. Furman’s board consists of 36 members, plus the trustees emeriti.

A graduate of Southern University, Johnson heads the Atlanta-based consulting firm Juan Johnson Consulting and Facilitation. As the Coca-Cola Company’s first vice president for diversity strategy, he helped the company handle the settlement of a class-action racial discrimination lawsuit.

Johnson partnered with the Riley Institute to develop an innovative Diversity Leaders Initiative in South Carolina in 2003. Since the start of the initiative, there have been more than 600 graduates of the program across the state.

Johnson gave the address at Furman’s Founders Convocation in March and was awarded an honorary Doctor of Humanities degree.
