

Emerging Public Leaders – Rules and Expectations Form

You will be living on campus with other students who are participating in *Emerging Public Leaders* as well as students who are participating in other Furman programs. It is important that each student understands and follows the rules/expectations that are listed below. These are in place to promote safety and an environment that will allow you to learn and to promote a sense of community. Many of these rules are based on policies set forth by University Housing.

University Housing Policies

Alcohol, tobacco, and drugs are not allowed on campus. Due to fire codes, matches, candles, and incense are not allowed on campus. It is against policy to tamper with fire alarms, fire extinguishers, and smoke detectors. You must evacuate the building if there is a fire alarm. You are responsible for room damage. You must leave your room as you found it. You are responsible for lost room keys. For your safety, do not prop open doors on stairwells or outside doors. Do not remove furniture from the room, and do not remove screens from the windows. For your safety and the safety of your belongings, rooms should be locked at all times. We cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Emerging Public Leaders Expectations

- Out of respect for others, we will not allow foul language. We will also not allow sexist, racist or otherwise offensive language.
- Please keep music low; it should not be loud enough to be heard in the hall.
- You should be in your room by 11 p.m.; lights out at 11:30 p.m. You may not wander out of your room.
- No boys on the girls' hall; no girls on the boys' hall.
- When you are not directly supervised by staff, you must have a buddy with you. Staff should know where you are at all times. **You may not leave the campus without written permission.**
- If you bring a car to Furman, you must give your keys to an *Emerging Public Leaders* staff member until the program is over.
- You may not bring a television or DVD Player to Furman. Cell phones should be used **only** during free time.
- You may bring a radio, CD player/iPod, and alarm clock, although we discourage you from bringing expensive electronic equipment, including cameras.
- You may not disregard or disrespect any *Emerging Public Leaders* staff members.
